

Church Periodical Club (CPC) Report

On March 8th a letter was sent to the ECW Convocation Coordinators reminding them that CPC Sunday is May 7th and that the parishes need to order their supplies immediately if they haven't already done so. At the same time an article was sent to Sally Sinclair requesting that it be published in the April **Apostle**.

During the last three months I have been a visitor at two convocation meetings. One of the Mountain Convocation in Guntersville and one in Heflin with the Cheaha Convocation.

I have received several letters from both the Province IV CPC Chair and from the National CPC office. The letters have generally been about activities connected with the CPC triennial meeting to be held at Procter Camp and Conference Center near Columbus, Ohio prior to the General Convention in June.

The letter from Barbara Owens, Province IV Representative to the national CPC Board, contained several requests for money. They are as follows:

Annual National Membership Dues	\$20.00
Contribution for the CPC Province IV Budget	25.00 (to \$50.00)
Money for candy for Energy Lift at Gen. Convention	<u>40.00</u>
TOTAL	\$85.00

In reviewing the Diocesan ECW budget of 2003 Brenda and I found that \$35 was sent for Energy Lift at the General Convention, so a precedent has been set for this contribution.

I recommend that we make the three payments totaling \$85.00 and that the amounts of \$20 and \$25 for national and Province IV be put in the budget for 2007 and future years.

I had planned to have CPC information on the Diocesan ECW web site by now, but have not worked on it. I will try to get information to Sally Sinclair for this within the next few weeks.
